



Corbels

A corbel is traditionally a support for an eave or bay window, though they can be entirely ornamental and serve no practical function.

Often they take the form of scrolls and can be cast or moulded. Many people use corbels as a feature underneath arches where columns are not necessary.

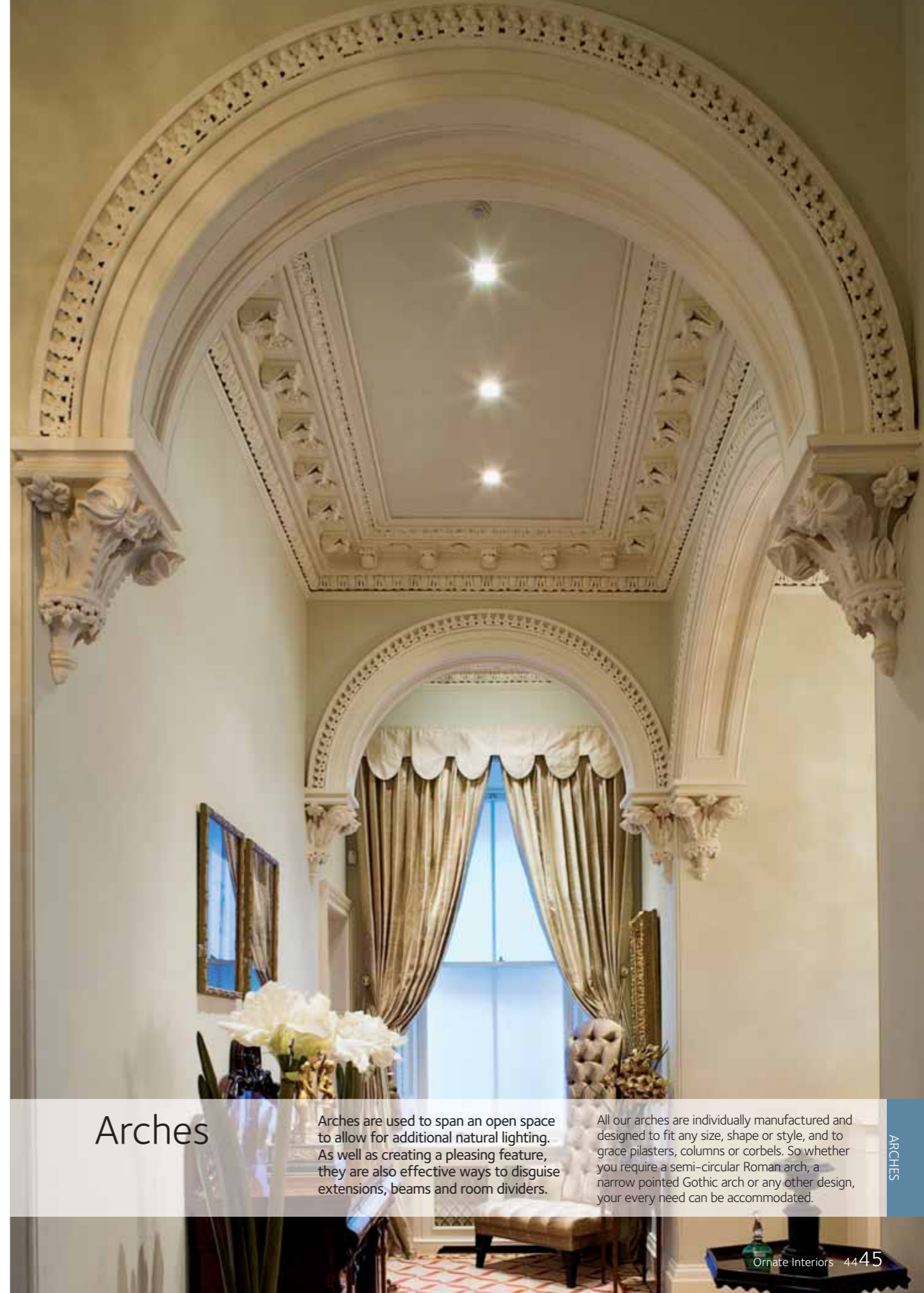
